Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

It has been a long time since the children have been able to get out of the compound much at all. They really miss the social activity of getting out to school to meet up with their other friends. A drive around town is a help but does not connect them with these friends. They are curious to see whatever is going on at the front gate (no wonder it is always being mended) and over the different fences. The children and staff are all healthy and are doing well.

We want to bring to your attention the big changes and expansion over the past years. That is **our outreach to the suffering children in the villages**. The medical clinic is going to be a big extension of what we have been doing for many years, but now we will be based in Lwambogo, so that we will catch children earlier in their illness.

This comes at a much greater expense as there are going to be a lot more children helped. Hopefully we can meet most of the medical needs at the clinic before the child is desperately ill, but we know from experience that there are many who will need specialized care at city facilities after our initial medical care. We humbly ask if you could assist this burden by increasing your regular monthly donation by \$10, \$25, \$50 or \$100 to help with this growing need. Our goal is to greatly reduce suffering and death in the young children. It is heartbreaking to see so many little ones suffer so badly and die a miserable death. Many have brought me to tears.
