What an answer to prayer!!! It was bitter sweet for us all when 12 of our children graduated from Welcome Home to a wonderful new future with security, love and a great education. Not alone but with11 friends!!

When you buy a new washing machine in the West you just go buy it and have it delivered and installed in a day or two. Not so for us. Ordered in November to come over the ocean from Europe, arrive in Mombassa Kenya, then clearing Kenyan customs, trucked to Kampala Uganda and then clearing Ugandan Customs and Duty. Meanwhile (see the pictures of our preparation) we re-roofed the building, excavated and installed a very sturdy laundry room floor, boosted the plumbing pipes, and made a much bigger door. The staff love the new machines and want you to know they are very thankful for your donations that made it possible.
