I went to OK my church plans for a new building in Lwambogo to house a vocational training school for training the locals with jobs. This will help reduce the poverty and the suffering of the little children. A sewing class with over 30 in attendance started on the 20<sup>th</sup> January. Hopefully they will end up as a co op making good money. Once the building is up Ben and his family will kick into high gear teaching mechanics and building and fish farming model for others to copy for themselves.

It is good to have all the children settled back into the newly renovated property that is serving us well. We so appreciate the Mahdvani group for all the investment for the sake of the children.

The children are happy and healthy. They come in a never ending stream. We are preparing 9 of them to go home soon if the families can manage them.
