Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

Thank you for all the many ways you make the work of Welcome Home possible. It is the faithful love and support of our sponsors that enables us to have the impact in the lives of the little ones of Uganda. Your help is vital to the ministry and is really appreciated by us all. Thank you! Thank you!

This month we are celebrating how many children we have been able to restore home over a 12 month period. Twenty eight children (15 girls and 13 boys) have been successfully restored into their families in the villages. And we have just as many again on the waiting list to go home. So when it is healthy for them to go, we have to make sure the family is in a good position to be able to receive them. They need to be ready to embrace them in their hearts, have a home (sustained food and shelter), and be willing to educate them so that they have a chance at a future.

People often ask "why give goats?" In a village setting 3 goats being bred will soon have a good herd (often twins) that can provide a good income to help with school fees for the child/children.

New little ones continue to come in. Sadly there is still a lot of maternal death in childbirth. We work with the dads to keep them involved to take their child home at 3 years old. We are also working with many mums to teach nutrition for healthy birth. Yay!!! This week we have a check from Amazon Smile for last quarter of 2017 for \$144.39. It helps.
