Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

This year is already well under way with lots of things happening in the ministry. Thirty two people have been for follow up medical treatment after being seen at the December clinic in Lwambogo (Kiko).

The first phase of the Calvary Life Fellowship church is under construction in Lwambogo. It is funded by the US church and is going to be used by Welcome Home for future Medical clinics and for the Kids Bible Team.

Oscar was "surprise" visited by Uncle William and the social workers to check on his well being. He is a little sad, having to make such a big adjustment but is doing well with his grandparents. He is being cared for.

Many of our staff are learning English and Computer skills, classes taught by Ruudy and Beckie at Kingdom Life Training Center (a part of Welcome Home).

We were successful in getting the dad of two of our children out of prison (we found out he was innocent, caught in the dragnet). He had been in for 4 years without any trial. He is now back working and is able to care for them. What a happy reunion for them all.

This past week we had three new admissions; two sisters (both parents are deceased), and a young boy whose mum is not able to cope.

Next month a proposed children's issues law with major effects goes to a vote in Parliament. We pray for the Bill to reflect what is best for the children.

Thank you all so much for your love and support. You make our ministry to the children possible.


